22 **NOTICE OF HEARING**

23 **A PUBLIC HEARING WILL BE HELD** before the Arizona Power Plant and  
24 Transmission Line Siting Committee (“Committee”) regarding the application of Chevelon  
25 Butte Wind RE, LLC (“Chevelon Butte”) for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility  
26 to authorize the Chevelon Butte Wind Gen-Tie Project (the “Project”). The Project consists  
27 of new 345 kilovolt (“kV”) transmission lines and associated interconnection facilities  
28 originating in Coconino County, Arizona, and interconnecting with the APS Preacher  
Canyon-Cholla 345 kV transmission line in Navajo County, Arizona. A map of the Project  
is attached as Exhibit A.

The hearing will commence at the High Country Conference Center, 201 W. Butler  
Avenue, Flagstaff, Arizona 86001, on September 16, 2019, at 1:00 p.m., and will continue  
on September 17, 2019, and September 18, 2019, as necessary, beginning at 9:00 a.m. on  
each day, unless a tour is taken. If a tour is taken, it will begin on September 17, 2019, at  
7:00 a.m. or at alternative date and time set by the Chairman of the Committee. If necessary,  
the hearing will continue September 19, 2019, at 9:00 a.m. at the Aspen Room, 2223 E.  
7th Ave C, Flagstaff, AZ 86004. Any revisions to the hearing schedule, if necessary, will

4 **PUBLIC COMMENT WILL BE TAKEN IN A SPECIAL EVENING**  
5 **SESSION ON SEPTEMBER 16, 2019, BEGINNING AT 6:00 P.M., AT THE HIGH**  
6 **COUNTRY CONFERENCE CENTER, 201 W. BUTLER AVENUE, FLAGSTAFF,**  
7 **ARIZONA 86001. PUBLIC COMMENT MAY BE TAKEN AT THE BEGINNING**  
8 **OF EACH HEARING DAY, OR AT OTHER TIMES DURING THE HEARING, AT**  
9 **THE DISCRETION OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE.**

10 The Chairman of the Committee may, at his discretion, recess the hearing to a time  
11 and place to be announced during the hearing, or to be determined after the recess. The  
12 date, time, and place at which the hearing will be resumed will be posted on the above-  
13 noted Project website and the ACC website. **NOTE: NOTICE OF ANY SUCH**  
14 **RESUMED HEARING WILL BE GIVEN; HOWEVER, PUBLISHED NOTICE OF**  
15 **SUCH A RESUMED HEARING IS NOT REQUIRED.**

16 The Committee may conduct a tour of the Project area. The map and itinerary of  
17 any such tour will be available at the hearing and posted on the Project website. Members  
18 of the public may follow the Committee on the tour. During the tour, the Committee may  
19 hear testimony at stops on the tour concerning where the stops are located, what is visible  
20 at the stops, and the relevance of the location and view to the Application and Project. No  
21 other discussion or deliberation concerning the Application will occur during the tour. A  
22 court reporter or recording device will record any testimony taken on the tour for  
23 transcription.

4           The Applicant will make available final copies of the pre-filing conference, pre-  
5 hearing conference, and hearing transcripts at each of the above locations and website.

6           Each county, municipal government, and state agency interested in the Project that  
7 desires to be a party to the proceedings shall, not less than ten days before the date set for  
8 the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC,  
9 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

10          Any domestic non-profit corporation or association formed in whole or in part to  
11 promote conservation or natural beauty, to protect the environment, personal health or  
12 other biological values, to preserve historical sites, to promote consumer interests, to  
13 represent commercial and industrial groups, or to promote the orderly development of the  
14 area in which the Project is located desiring to become a part to the proceedings shall, not  
15 less than ten days before the date set for the hearing, file a Notice of Intent to Become a  
16 Party with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona  
17 85007.

18          The Committee or the Chairman, at any time deemed appropriate, may make other  
19 persons parties to the proceedings. Any person may make a limited appearance at a hearing  
20 by filing a statement in writing with the Director of Utilities, ACC, 1200 West Washington  
21 Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, not less than five days before the date set for the hearing.  
22 A person making a limited appearance will not be a party or have the right to present  
23 testimony or cross-examine witnesses.

24          This proceeding is governed by Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 40-360 to 40-  
25 360.13 and Arizona Administrative Code Rules R14-3-201 to R14-3-220. No substantive  
26 communication, not in the public record, may be made to any member of the Committee.  
27 The written decision of the Committee will be submitted to the ACC pursuant to A.R.S.

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1 § 40-360.07. Any person intending to be a party to the proceedings on the matter before  
2 the ACC must be a party to the proceedings before the Committee.
